- 1) Meeting called to order at 6:02 p.m. by PFC Chair Olson.
- 2) Roll Call: PFC Members present: L. Olson, R. Rule, Z. Kianovsky, L. O'Donnell, T. Sumnicht. (City Counsel Liaison Trina Reid also appeared )
- 3) Notice of compliance with Open Meeting law—Notice of Meeting and Posted Agenda by Olson.
- 4) Motion by Sumnicht to approve agenda. Seconded by O'Donnell. Motion carried unanimously. Motion to approve minutes of meeting of 06/09/2021 by O'Donnell, seconded by Rule. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5) Public Comments: Ryan Rostad of Franklin Street, Columbus, commented regarding the agenda of the 06-09-21 meeting not being on the Fire Department website, and commented relevant to the selection of the new CFD Chief. Jerad Fox of Tower Dr., Columbus, commented relevant to the selection of the new CFD Chief.

Roll call vote: Sumnicht- Aye; Rule- Aye; Olson- Aye; Kianovsky-Aye; O'Donnell- Aye. Motion carried unanimously.
- 8) Motion by Rule to adjourn. Seconded by Sumnicht. Motion carried unanimously.
