Available for City of Columbus residents!

Hours of Operation: April 2, 2022 - November 26, 2022

Monday/Wednesday 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm Saturday 8:00 am - 3:00 pm

Current year sticker with assigned number is required on your LRC tag. Can be picked up at DPW during normal business hours.

RESIDENTS:

Residents can obtain a required rear-view hanger at our Public Works Department at 229 E. School Street, Monday - Friday, 7:00 am - 3:30 pm, along with proof of residency (Drivers License, addressed Utilities or Tax Bill). (\$25 fee for Town of Elba Residents) Residents must show rear-view hanger to the attendant to enter the Landscape Recycling Center. Residents performing yard work on their property located within city limits can use the center without restrictions for approved materials.

CONTRACTORS:

Contractors can obtain a required rear-view hanger at our Public Works Department at 229 E. School Street, Monday - Friday, 7:00 am - 3:30 pm, along with proof of Business Contact Information and Drivers License, along with a \$25 fee. Contractors performing contracted work for City of Columbus residents must provide a "Consent To Use" form for each job. Form must be completed by the City of Columbus resident and/or property owner they are performing the work for. All information MUST be filled in for follow-up verification. If form is not filled in completely access will be denied. No combined loads. Contractors that live in the City of Columbus and do not provide a consent form will be limited to 3 cubic yards of approved material per week. Contractors performing work outside the city limits are restricted from using the Columbus Landscape Recycling Center. Contractors must show rear-view hanger to the attendant to enter the Landscape Recycling Center.

Acceptable Items:

- ◆ Yard items - leaves, grass clippings, brush, yard waste (free of plastic bags and rocks)
- ◆ Used motor oil - Please do not leave your oil containers.
- ◆ Scrap metal-bicycles, washers, dryers, stoves, range tops, water heaters, dishwashers, and other small miscellaneous metals.
- ◆ Vehicle batteries
- ◆ Cardboard



Items NOT Accepted:

- ◆ Landscaping fabric
- ◆ Rocks
- ◆ Railroad ties
- ◆ Construction material
- ◆ Cooking oil
- ◆ Wood chips or barrels
- ◆ Dehumidifiers, refrigerators, water coolers, air conditioners, microwaves, freezers,

BRUSH PICKUP - Brush will be picked up curbside, the first full week of April through the first full week of October, on the first Monday of the month. Brush must be placed on the tree border by 7:00 am on Monday. Brush is defined as limbs 8" or less in diameter, with ends facing the same way. Twigs less than 1" should be placed with yard waste and taken to the Landscape Recycling Center. Should a holiday fall on a Monday, brush pickup will move to Tuesday.

LEAF PICKUP - Weather permitting, leaves will be picked up the second full week of October through the third full week of November. Place leaves on the curb, not bagged, no later than 7:00 am on the Monday of your scheduled week of pickup. Do not put leaves around posts, guide wires, etc. Do not park cars by leaf piles. Schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions. A map of pickup routes/dates is available at DPW or can be found on the city website at <https://www.cityofcolumbuswi.com>.
