Memorial Plaques for Honor Trees

Residents who purchase an honor tree can also purchase a memorial plaque to place in front of the tree on the ground. This isn't necessary.

Residents would have to acquire the plaques on their own through a business since Public Works does not purchase supply them.

Public Works has restrictions on the size and material of the memorial plaques. For more information, see the section below. Public Works should be given the memorial plaque to place on the ground. The plaque cannot be placed by the resident themselves.

Size Limitations:

Plaques must be a maximum of 11 X 14 inches.

Material Options:

Plaques must be made of aluminum, bronze or holly bronze.

No memorial rocks or stones are allowed.

Sample Plaque (for reference only):

Plaque does not have to be identical to this but must meet the size and material requirements.
